## Dear Students/Parents/Guardians:

This week, each student received the "Current Events" graphic organizer in their #8 Current Event/Book Talk section of their ELA/SS binder. They will take this home when they are assigned a Current Event. Throughout the year, students will be finding articles and sharing them during our Social Studies class **via presentation or recording to Flipgrid (Flipgrid link will be on Google Classroom)**. I think it is very important that students know what is going on in the world around them. With that being said, I want the kids to find <u>meaningful</u>, <u>appropriate</u>, and <u>informational</u> articles to share with the class. While I am a big Patriots fan, an article on them winning week 12 isn't exactly newsworthy or educational to the class. Try and find something that can relate to what we are studying, or that is educational or helpful to know.

## Overview:

Students will find articles and present them to the class based on current events happening in the world. They will fill out the graphic organizer, attach the article and be prepared to present to the class in a 2-3 minute presentation.

### **Objectives:**

- Use newspapers, magazines, articles, online/television to find current events
- Find the main idea of the article
- Identify the important people/things in the article.
- Identify the location
- Identify the author and the publication
- Use map and globe skills
- Make a text to self, text to world, text to text, or text to history connection

Students should practice beforehand and not simply "read" from their paper. We discussed in class good presentation techniques!

- Eye contact
- Speaking loudly/clearly
- Knowing your article
- Practice at home with someone or in front of a mirror!
- Use visuals, props, etc to liven up the presentation
