


Cloud Flap Book FREEBIE!

Materials:

Blue Cardstock

Cotton balls (enough for each student to have 4)

Glue bottle

Instructions:

- 1. Print template on blue cardstock.
- 2. Study the pictures of each cloud type and come up with a short description for each.
- 3. Shape cotton balls to look like each type of cloud and glue on the front.
- 4. Cut flaps on dotted lines. Fold on solid line.
- 5. Write the descriptions for each cloud under the flap.

ollililililililil Suggested Descriptions Stratus: Flat, pancake-like clouds that cover the sky. Cirrus: Flat, wispy clouds that can be many shapes. Cumulus: Tall, fluffy clouds that look like cotton. Cumulonimbus: Tall, dark storm clouds that can have lightning and thunder.


